WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Collection facility and mobile facility staff, collection event staff, local health department staff, and others who have responsibilities related to the efficient and safe collection handling of these solid wastes.

This course is taking a detailed look at the issues and problems unique to managing collection of household hazardous waste both at collection facility and "collection days". The Canadian content is designed to include both classroom time and discussion in a condensed two day version of the SWANA course.

The course has been developed to provide "common sense" instruction to the participants regarding the safe and practical operation of a HHW facility. Although focused on facility operations, there is significant overlap in material that is applicable to collection events. The results should be beneficial to the participants, facility owners/operators, and event sponsors

OBJECTIVE:

To provide a common framework for collection and handling of materials regarded as being Household Hazardous Waste or Conditional Exempt Small Quantity Generators (HHW/CESQG).

UPON COMPLETION OF THIS COURSE, PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ABLE TO:

- Reduce the risk of hazardous materials exposure to the public and facility workers
- Reduce the risk of accidental discharges of hazardous substances to the environment
- Assist in fostering public education and knowledge of the on-going operation of fixed collection facilities and collection events

COURSE CONTENT:

The course manual is meant to cover common OSHA topics applicable to HHW collection operations and may satisfy a significant part of classroom hazardous materials training requirements for operations and supervisory staff in states which have such requirements or recommendations. - health hazards
- operational hazards
- personal protective equipment
- waste management issues
- emergency preparedness
