### **SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM**

The B.C. Chapter of the Solid Waste Association of North America is offering a number of \$1000 scholarships to encourage students studying in disciplines related to solid waste management and environmental protection.

**Recipients of the scholarships will be determined by a panel of SWANA B.C. Chapter**

**Directors and will be chosen on the basis of:**

- intended course of studies and its relation to solid waste management
- academic performance
- involvement in school and community activities
- involvement in activities besides regular course work which is related to solid waste management or environmental protection
- a brief written submission as described in item 7 of the application form (**500 words or less**)
- references

Preference may be given to SWANA members or their immediate relatives.

Recipients of 2010 SWANA Scholarships are not eligible for awards in 2011 but will become eligible again in 2012.

Requirements:

- Completed applications must be received on or before October 15, 2011.
- **Applicants must be registered in a full course of studies in an environmental management or a related program at a recognized post-secondary institution in British Columbia.**
- Applicants must have completed their first year of post-secondary studies.

To be considered for one of these scholarships, the applicant must submit the following:

- completed application form (over)
- written submission as described in 7. (over)
- transcript or copy of last year's statement of marks
- reference letter from a faculty member
- proof of registration for Fall or Winter session, 2011 - 2012

Applicants receiving scholarships will be notified before November 15, 2011. Awards will be made at the SWANA Annual General Meeting in late November.
