Course Content

This 3-day course consists of 21 lessons and includes classroom exercises, case studies, and a half-day field exercise at a local landfill. This session runs Tuesday Nov 29 thru Thursday Dec 1, 2011

Manager of Landfill Operations Course and Landfill Certification Exam

Approved Solid Waste Management Plans require a certified landfill operator to be onsite when a landfill is open and operating. Regulatory inspectors are also required to be landfill certified. Certification through the Solid Waste Association of North America (SWANA) meets Solid Waste Management Plan requirements. The certification is also recognized in many other provinces and states in North America. Individuals from other provinces and states are welcome to attend. The Manager of Landfill Operations (MOLO) course prepares you for the Landfill Certification examination by providing information on the latest landfill operating techniques and technologies.

Sign-in will begin at 7:00 am on the first day. A full breakfast is included and will be available each day beginning at 7:00 am. Instruction will begin each day at 8:00 am and will end by 5 pm. Lunch will be provided. The optional Certification exam will be available on Dec 2, 2011.

A general course outline is available on www.swana.org. If you feel you are a competent in all areas covered in the course, you may take the optional Certification exam without taking the MOLO class; however, most first time exam takers prefer to take the course first.

Audience

The primary audience for the MOLO course is Landfill Managers (those individuals responsible for the management of day-to-day operation of a landfill) and Landfill Inspectors (those responsible for enforcing regulatory requirements). Others who can benefit from attending the course include solid waste directors, public works directors, lead equipment operators, landfill designers, landfill permit writers and others in the field of landfill management.

Faculty

This course will be taught by two highly qualified MOLO certified instructors possessing many years of experience in landfill design, management, operations, and field inspections.

What to bring and wear:

Please bring a calculator capable of handling seven digits for class activities. Also, bring your stories of interesting events at your landfill as well as any questions you may have. Casual clothing is suitable for the classroom, but bring adequate clothing for the field exercise on Wednesday afternoon, including a coat, rain gear, and shoes or boots. We're going out there rain or shine and will be outside for about three hours.
